Second Reading *Romans 3: 21-25. 28*

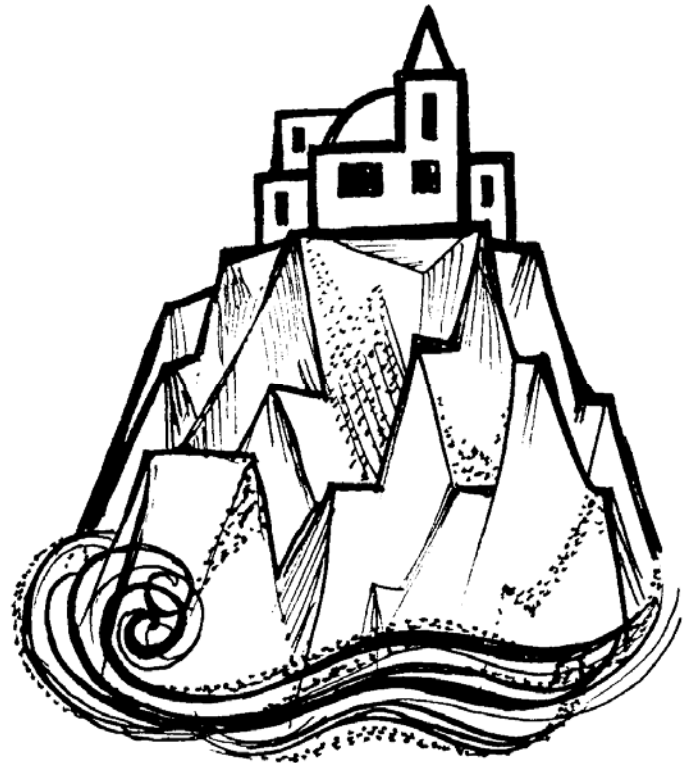
By the gift of grace redemption in Christ is possible for us all if we repent.
