#### **First Reading: Zechariah 12: 10-11**

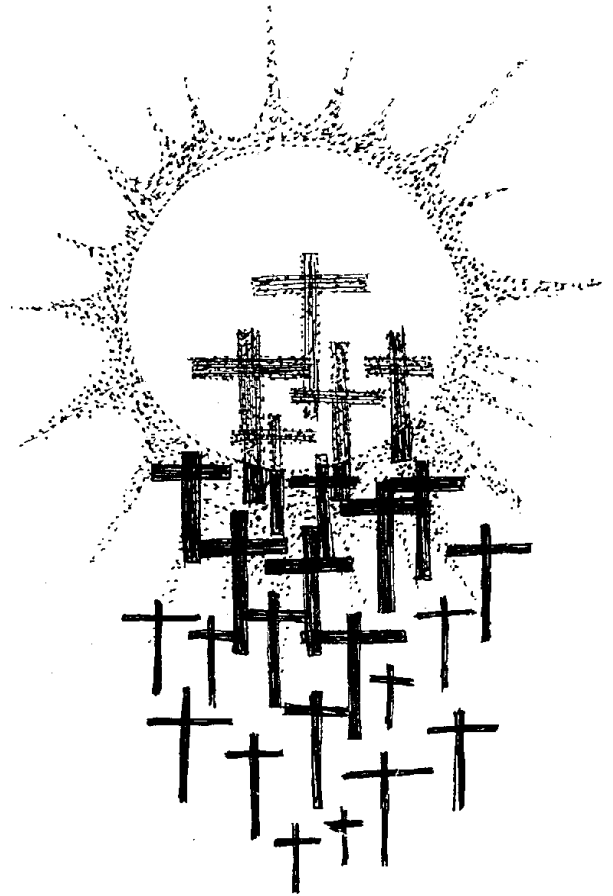
An ancient prophecy tells of restoration and of the death of an innocent one.
