#### **Second Reading: Philippians 2: 6-11**

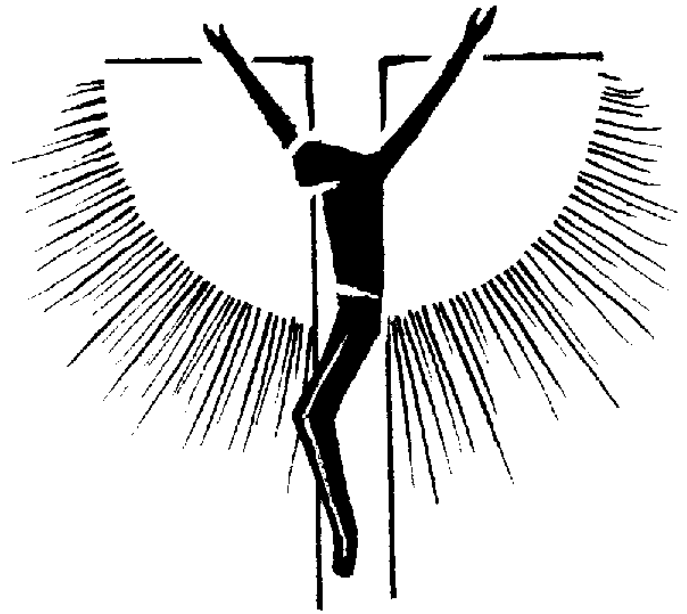
Jesus emptied himself and was exalted by God.
