#### **Gospel: John 16: 12-15**

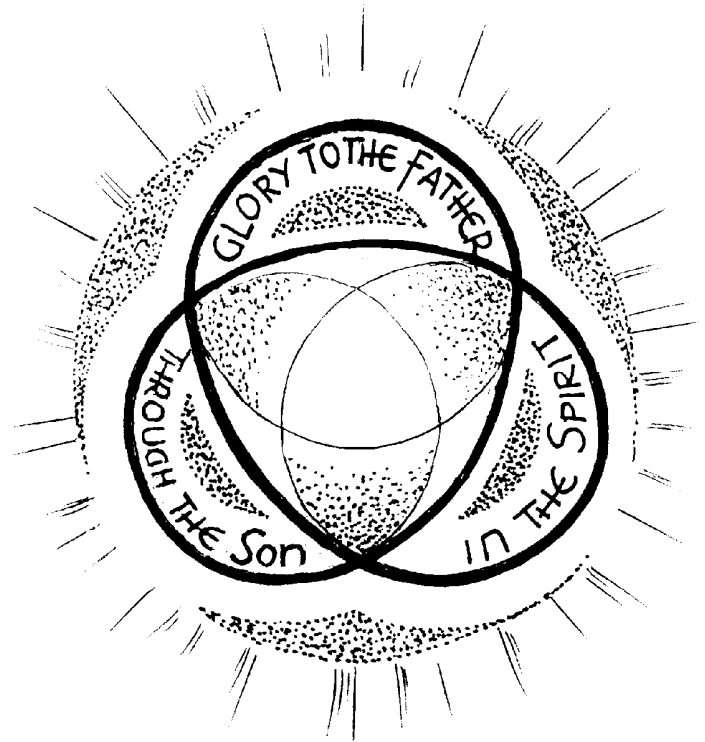
The Holy Spirit will be our guide through the mysteries of life.
