Second Reading: Colossians 3: 1-4

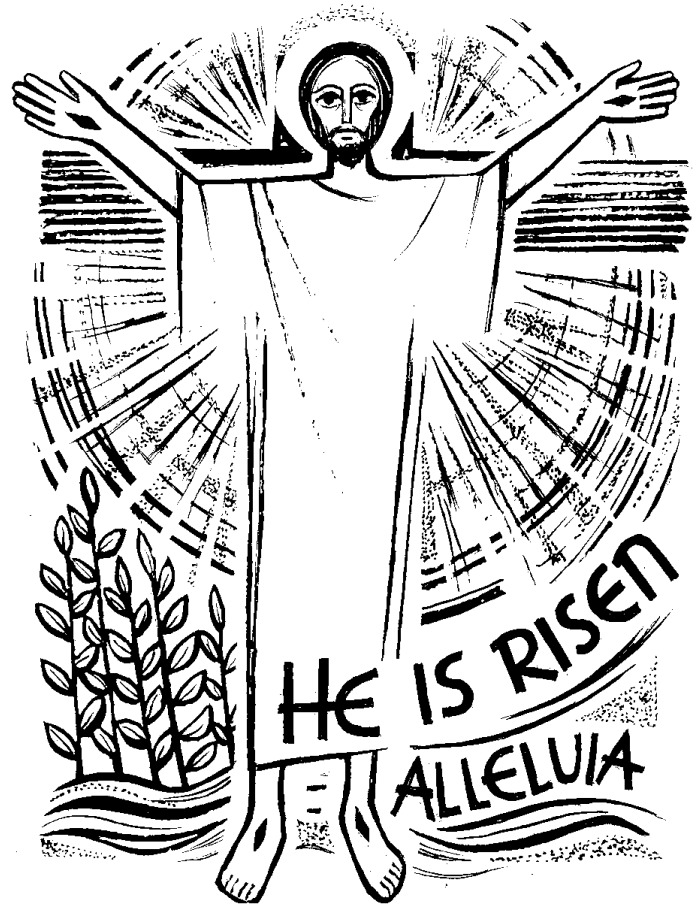
Christ did not rise for his own sake, but in order to bring all of us to resurrection.
