The gospel of Christ, entrusted to the Church, is now in our hands. Jesus tells us not to be afraid, but to let our lives preach his name.

First Reading *Isaiah 6: 1-8*

The prophet Isaiah receives a vision of God. The experience makes him realise his own unworthiness.

Second Reading: *1 Corinthians 15: 1-11*

Paul restates the truth of the resurrection, and recalls his own amazing experience of the risen Lord.

Gospel: *Luke 5: 1-11*

A multitude gathers by the lake. They witness a multitude of fish in nets. From these multitudes, the first followers of Christ are called.
